At the bottom of the poster you will note an open space for you to add your own information.

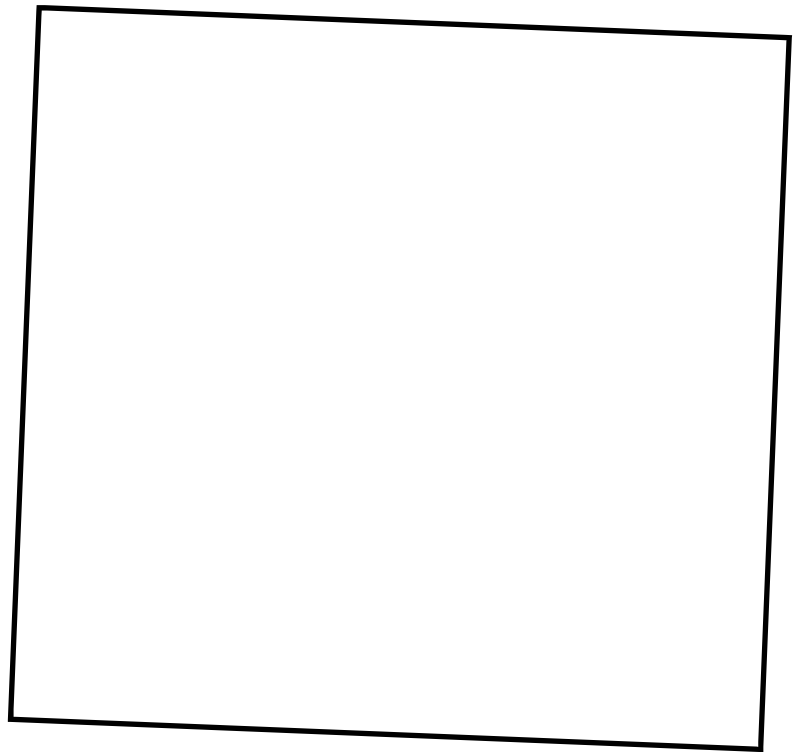
